

Endoscopic Orthopedic Surgery



Endoscopic Orthopedic Surgery represents a significant advancement in the field the orthopedics, offering patients a less invasive option with quicker recovery and better outcomes. This advanced approach involves using a puncture wound and specialized instruments to perform surgical procedures on bones, joints and soft tissues.

One of the key advantages of such a procedure is the reduced trauma to the surrounding tissues compared to traditional open surgery. This results in less pain, minimal scarring and faster recovery. Additionally, it leads to shorter hospital stays(day case) and a lower risk of complications. Common endoscopic orthopedic surgeries include arthroscopic procedures for the knee, shoulder, hip, and ankle joints. Surgeons use a tiny camera called an arthroscope to visualize the internal structures and guide their instruments with precision. This allows for the repair of ligaments, tendons, cartilage and other structures without the need for a large incision.
